

Men's Club Trip to The Museum of the Bible November 2, 2018



On a snowy November day ten Men's Club members went by Metro to the Museum of the Bible. Although the building originally was the ice house for the District of Columbia, it is completely modern inside. There were state of the art displays including a virtual reality tour of Israel.
