ENTERING GRADES 2-7

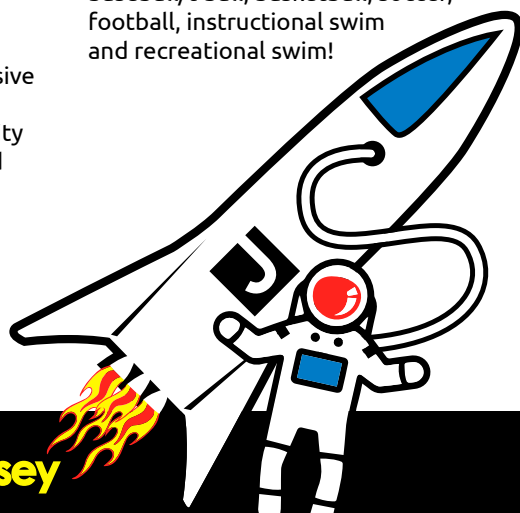

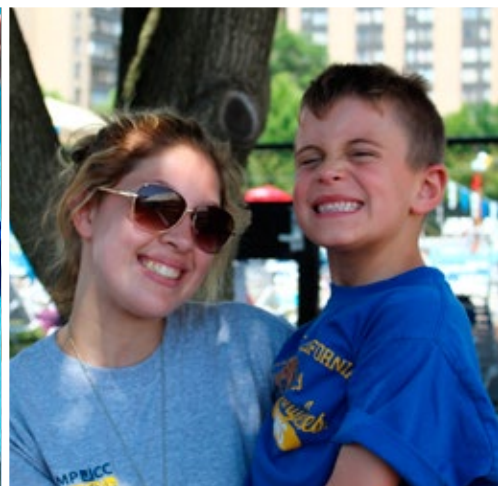
