The story of the dramatic escape of European Jews from Nazicontrolled Europe to Shanghai on the eve of World War II. The film recounts the courageous intervention of Ho Feng Shan, the Chinese Consul in Vienna, who defied his own government and braved the Gestapo to issue visas to the desperate refugees.
