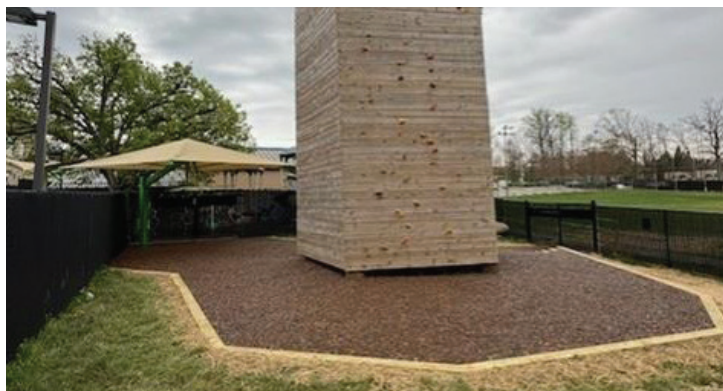

The Bender JCC relies on the generosity of the community for 25 percent of our annual budget. Each year, we provide \$400,000 in financial assistance to ensure that our programs and services are open to all. This report highlights the meaningful impact that Bender JCC programs and events have on the community.



ACCESSIBILITY INITIATIVES

The climbing tower that was installed on our campus in 2021 is accessible for campers with disabilities, but the grassy area surrounding the tower was difficult for anyone with mobility challenges to navigate. Through the generosity of the Robert I. Schattner Foundation and Carol and Robert Burman, that area has been covered by accessible rubber flooring that is commonly used as a playground surface.
